

WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

In order to sustainably and responsibly manage waste produced while carrying out the work, at your premises, we ask that you cooperate toward a shared accountability in this process.

Effective waste management requires both parties' commitment and effort. Thus, we would like to share a few guidelines to facilitate coordination:

1. Separating and Classifying Waste:

It becomes mandatory for all residues to be separated and classified according to their type (for example: metals, plastics, cardboard/paper, unsorted, etc.). This action speeds up appropriate recycling / disposal, significantly reducing environmental impact.

2. Use of Containers and Storage Areas:

Whenever the amount of waste generated by the works carried out by TECNOCON so require, we will provide specific containers for each type of waste, and we will ask that such containers be used in accordance with the stated purpose and that their location on site be observed in order to ensure efficiency and safety. Alternatively, by agreement between both parties, the waste produced may be managed by the Customer, by packaging it and sending it for appropriate treatment.

3. Abiding by Safety and Environmental Standards:

Our team undertakes to abide by applicable safety and environmental standards. Should you have other teams conducting work simultaneously, we ask that they be called upon to do the same, to prevent risks and contribute to collective well-being and sustainability.

4. Participating in Monitoring:

We invite you to collaborate in waste monitoring to ensure that such waste is managed in accordance with regulations and your company's sustainability goals. This sharing of responsibility is essential for successful work.

5. Active Communication:

We ask that we be quickly informed of any issue or additional need so as to adjust waste management strategies in real time, thereby ensuring compliance with all legal requirements.

We believe that, together, we can minimize environmental impacts caused by works while fostering responsible and sustainable practices.
